



Electrocardiogram (EKG)

An electrocardiogram (EKG) test is a simple, painless procedure that measures electrical signals in your heart. Each time your heart beats, an electrical signal travels through the heart. An EKG can show if your heart is beating at a normal rate and strength.

- Please wear comfortable clothing
- Arrive 30 minutes prior to your scheduled appointment to register

Upon arrival, you will be registered and escorted to an exam room where you will be asked about your medical history. If lab work is needed, it will be completed prior to the exam. The exam only takes about 15 minutes.
